

Town of Independence
End of Year Meeting
December, 30, 2020

The Independence Town Board met in the Town Hall on December 30, 2020 at 5pm for the End of the Year Meeting.

Present: Supervisor Reichman; Council: Meunier, Ellison, Howe, Brubaker; Town Clerk, Bledsoe; Town Book keeper, Welch; Highway Superintendent, Acomb
Visitors: 0

Supervisor Reichman called the meeting to order.

Book keeper, Cindy Welch, started by giving the board a report of the final financials for 2020, answering questions, and giving recommendations.

After discussion the following were decided:

- Motion was made by Supervisor Reichman, seconded by Council Howe and carried by all to move \$4,000 from the Water Savings Fund into the Capital Water Fund.
- Motion was made by Council Meunier, seconded by Council Howe and carried by all to move the following from the General Fund:
 - \$10,000 to Reval Fund
 - \$10,000 to Develop a new "Playground Fund"
 - \$15,000 to Salt Shed Fund
- Motion was made by Supervisor Reichman, seconded by Council Meunier and carried by all to pay \$250 toward a Rental Fee for the electronic town Sign.

Board discussed new Water Dept hire, Austin Waite. A motion was made by Supervisor Reichman, seconded by Council Meunier and carried by all to pay for classes to begin certification for his Class C Water license.

Board discussed the bids on work needing to be done on the Town Barns from the December Regular meeting. A motion was made by Council Meunier, seconded by Council Brubaker and carried by all to hire Ken Stebbins based on his submitted bid.

Bills were reviewed with a motion made by Supervisor Reichman, seconded by Council Meunier and carried by all to pay abstracts #12B-2020 in the following amounts:
