

Town of Independence
Special Meeting
June 24, 2021

The Town Board of the Town of Independence met in Town Hall on June 24, 2021 at 7pm for a special meeting.

Supervisor Reichman called the meeting to order.

After the Special meeting on June 17, book keeper Cindy Welch requested that the Board reconsider their decision on how to purchase the 2022 Mack truck for the Highway Dept. Supervisor Reichman handed out a work sheet and write up from the book keeper comparing the Highway financials to other years and offering up a recommendation on another avenue of purchase as she does not recommend using the \$100,000 out of the Highway savings. Acomb then discussed with the Board the information that he had gotten from the representative from the CHIP department at the state. After much discussion a motion was made by Supervisor Reichman, seconded by Council Howe and carried by all to use \$10,000 from the Highway Equipment Fund and designate revenue from the sale of the current truck toward the down payment and bond the remainder, allocating CHIPS money to pay the principal on the bond each year.

Supervisor Reichman to send letter of intent to buy to Beam Mack Sales & Service.

A motion to adjourn was made by Council Meunier, seconded by Supervisor Reichman and carried by all.
